Mathletics

The school has purchased a new online computer program called Mathletics. This program can be accessed by every student from school and home. Each student will be given a unique username and password **THAT CANNOT BE CHANGED**. Teachers will be able to set specific topics from the NSW Board of Studies mathematics curriculum and individual programs best suited to the students needs and abilities. It is used by 3.5 million students from K-12 worldwide bringing fun into learning maths. An introductory afternoon will be offered to parents early next year.

Student Behaviour

I am often the first person to praise the great behaviour of the children at Kearsley Public School.
