## **Open Forum**

My sincere thanks to the parents who came alone to the open forum last Tuesday afternoon and / or completed the online survey (8 parents completed the survey). The afternoon was very informative for the staff and it has certainly given us direction for 2013. Some of the issues raised were:

Communication from school to parents, fair treatment/bullying/respect/tokens, breakfast club.

The staff are now looking at the information that is provided in the notes going home and a colour system will also assist parents to know if information needs to be returned.

A small group of parents and teachers will visit other schools next year to have a look at their Positive Behaviour for Learning (PBL) program to see if we can make changes to improve the system of discipline and rewards for the students at KPS. The PBL lessons will also have a greater focus on tolerance/ respect and provide guidance about dealing with inappropriate behaviour at school. With these ideas and working with the community I am confident we can build a better school. We will provide more information early next year about these issue and any changes.

The teachers are in the process of forming classes for next year. At this stage we are looking at Mrs Pitt - Kindergarten, Mrs Singleton (Uhle) - 1/2, Mrs Fairlie - 2/3, Mr Falla-4/5 and Mrs Thompson - 5/6.
