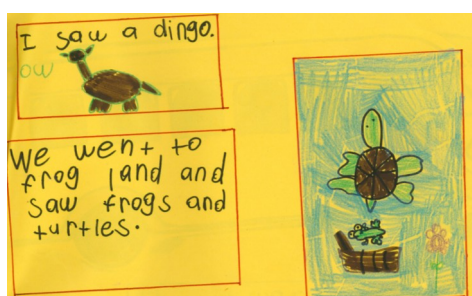
Blokes Breakfast
