Canberra Excursion

Years 5 & 6 have the opportunity to participate in a 4 day excursion to Canberra on Tuesday 2 September till Friday 5 September 2014. This is an exciting, fun-packed experience for all students. The cost will be approximately \$400.00 which includes return coach transport, accommodation, all meals (except lunch on Day 1), and all activities.

This cost has been based on 28 students so the cost could change slightly depending on definite numbers. We will endeavour to do some fundraising to bring this cost down for families. Notes were given to students last week. Expressions of Interest are now overdue and need to be returned to Ms Thompson by **tomorrow**. NB: There MAY BE an opportunity for parents to attend at the same cost as students – please tick the box on the note if interested. A payment plan has been devised so families can budget for the trip. A \$50 deposit needs to be paid by **28 March 2014. Payments can be made at anytime at the office.**

School Cross Country

On Friday 21 March 2014, our school will be holding a cross country run for all Yrs 3 – 6 children. This will enable us to pick our team for the Zone Cross Country. The race will be at Jeffery Park, Kearsley. We will be walking from school at 9.30am to the park. We will walk the track and the race starting time will be approx. 10am. We will be returning to school by lunchtime. Please ensure your child is wearing their sports uniform, joggers and hat. Students aged 8, 9 or 10 years old will run 2 laps each, 11, 12 and 13 year olds will run 3 laps each.




