
Interrelate & Healthy Harold

Swimming School

Students in Year 2,3 and 4 will be participating in this 10 day Intensive Swimming program with spaces left over offered to selected students who are non swimmers. The program commences on Monday 28 October and runs until Friday 8 November, weeks 3 and 4. As our Year 3-4 camp falls on the 7 and 8 November, Year 3 and 4 will not be required to attend on these last 2 days of swim school. The total cost (\$63 per student) will be paid for by the school and the Sporting Schools Program, a bus will be used to transport the children. Students will need to bring swimmers, towel, dry underwear, sunscreen, a plastic bag for wet clothing and a hair brush or comb each day. Please make sure all belongings are clearly labelled with your child's name as we are not the only school using the facilities. Permission notes were sent home earlier this week to participating students.


